## CHANGES TO THE DCFS DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING PROGRAM (PART II)

This FYI Bulletin announces additional changes to the DCFS Drug and Alcohol Testing Program and is considered Part II to the previously released FYI Bulletin, Part 1, of June 29, 2020.

This FYI Bulletin is to inform DCFS staff of additional changes to the DCFS Drug and Alcohol Testing Program effective August 12, 2020 for changes in the panel of drugs, and on August 1, 2020 on changes to the collection sites.

The DCFS Drug and Alcohol Testing Program assists CSWs in determining if a DCFS-supervised child/youth can safely remain in the home of his/her parent/caregiver when past or current substance abuse has been identified, as well as to facilitate the reunification of children with the ir parent(s)/caregiver.

Effective July 1, 2020, the contracted vendor that serves the DCFS Drug and Alcohol Testing Program is Pacific Toxicology.

### 1. Changes to the Drug Panel

As of August 12, 2020, the following is the drug panel that DCFS clients will be tested for through On-demand testing, along with the Random and Weekly programs:

- Opiate panel: morphine, codeine & hydrocodone (Vicodin);
- Amphetamines: amphetamine, methamphetamine & MDMA (Ecstasy);
- Cocaine metabolites;
- Cannabinoids (marijuana); and
- Phencyclidine (PCP)

(Commonly referenced as the Five Drug Panel.)

In addition, DCFS clients will also be testing for the following drugs:

- Hydromorphone
- Oxycodone
- Heroin
- Methadone;
- Zolpidem; and
- Benzodiazepine (alprazolam, clonazepam, lorazepam, diazepam, iazepam, oxazepam, and temazepam)



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The second list of drugs have been added towards establishing a more comprehensive drug panel and is an important component of the DCFS Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.

As a reminder, testing for alcohol and all the above drugs are included when submitting a referral for alcohol and drugs for On-demand, Random and Weekly testing.

## 2. New DCFS Drug and Alcohol Testing Program's Collection Sites as of August 1, 2020

The DCFS Drug and Alcohol Collection Sites have changed due to the implementation of a new contract with the current vendor, Pacific Toxicology. (Please see the attached list for DCFS Drug and Alcohol Testing Collection Sites).
