## **Assembly Bill 829- Undocumented Children/Nonminor Dependents**

Per Assembly Bill (AB) 829 anytime the department becomes aware that a child/nonminor dependent (NMD) is undocumented the department/CSW is to:

•	Inform the child/NMD's attorney of the dependent child/NMD's immigration status electronically or by telephone within 5 business days of the department finding out. CSW is to complete a Notice to Child's/NMD's Attorney RE: Case Status form <a href="DCFS5402">DCFS5402</a> . When completing the DCFS 5240 form the CSW is to provide the information in the Other/Sensitive Information section.

•	Provide the undocumented child/NMD under the jurisdiction of the juvenile court with access to immigration legal services.
