# CAMPERSHIP PROGRAM-SUMMER 2023 CAMPERSHIP ENROLLMENT

The Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) Campership Program provides financial support for eligible children and youth **to attend one camp session per summer**. Additionally, there are two (2) **FREE** summer day camp options: the Los Angeles County Beaches and Harbors Beach Adventure Camps and the California Science Center Science Week Camps. Campership Program eligible children and youth are ages 6 through 17, must have an open DCFS case, and be assessed by their Children's Social Worker (CSW) as appropriate to participate in a supervised overnight or day camp experience. Camp vendors may have different eligibility requirements.

Children and youth must be in an open DCFS case when they are <u>registered</u>; however, the case can be closed after enrollment.

Only the camps listed below are approved by the DCFS Campership Program.

## **CAREGIVER OR CSW**

Caregiver or CSW are responsible to <u>register directly</u> with the Camp Vendor by completing a <u>Camp</u> <u>Vendor Registration form for each child</u> (found on the camp website below).

#### **CAMPERSHIP REIMBURSED CAMP SESSIONS**

Caregivers may select one reimbursed summer camp session per child from the vendor list below.

- Camp vendors will stop accepting Campership-reimbursed registrations once their maximum has been reached.
- Enrollment for Campership reimbursed camps will be on a first-come, first-registered basis.

# RESPONSIBILITIES OF CAMPERSHIP INVOLVED PARTIES

# **THE CAREGIVER OR CSW WILL:**

- Select **ONE** of the camps listed above.
- Complete the selected Camp Vendor Registration forms.

## **THE CAMP VENDORS WILL:**

• Submit a list to the Campership Program of DCFS children registered in their camp sessions for pre-approval.

# THE CAMPERSHIP PROGRAM TEAM WILL:

· Confirm eligibility of each child.





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- Send the approved and ineligible list to Camp Vendors.
- Create and update Campership Master List showing approved, ineligible and duplicate names
  of children (those enrolled in two or more camp sessions or who already attended a camp this
  year).
- Work with caregivers, CSWs and camp vendors regarding enrollment issues, such as confirming which camp a child will attend when duplicate enrollments are identified.

## **THE CSW WILL:**

- Assist Campership Program Team to confirm, as needed, the name and date of birth (DOB) for the child(ren).
- Notify Campership Program Team regarding concerns about a registered child's appropriateness for a camp.

# PROCESS FOR POST-CAMP FOLLOW-UP

#### **CSW'S WILL:**

- As soon as possible, inform the Campership Program of any issues with the summer camp experience.
- Document in the Case Notes each child's camp experience.

#### **CAMP VENDORS WILL:**

- Provide a Camp Satisfaction Survey with a stamped self-addressed envelope to the child/youth
  or caregiver at the end of camp; to be completed by the child or caregiver after the child returns
  home.
- Submit sign-in logs for all DCFS children showing the <u>children's</u> signatures, typed names and DOB for each camp session.

#### **CAMPERSHIP PROGRAM TEAM WILL:**

- Review Sign-in signature logs and submit 250 Procurement requests for reimbursement to the vendors.
- Reimbursement checks will be paid directly to the camp vendors after sign-in logs are received with the children's signatures confirming camp attendance.





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## **FREE CAMP SESSIONS**

In addition to the Campership reimbursed camp sessions, Caregivers may enroll children in <u>each</u> of the following two free camp opportunities:

# **Beaches and Harbors Summer 2023 Beach Adventure Camps:**

The Department of Beaches and Harbor (DBH) is offering four free five-day Summer Beach Adventure Camps for up to **25** DCFS supervised children.

## Camp dates are from:

June 13 through June 16 - ages 7 to 12

June 20 through June 23 – ages 13 to 17

July 21 through July 28 – ages 7 to 12

July 31 through August 4 – ages 13 to 17

# **Beach activities may include:**

Surfing, Boogie Boarding, Sailing, Hiking, Kayaking, Stand-Up Paddle Board, Visit to Lifeguard HQ, dependent on the weather and surf conditions.

#### **Caregivers must provide:**

A sack lunch, swimwear (worn under street clothes and spare change of clothes), towel, beach shoes/sandals, backpack for each child and refillable water bottle.

Sun block should be applied to each child prior to departure by the caregiver.

DBH will provide up to two vans that can accommodate up to 13 passengers, with pick-up locations to be determined.

- 4. Beaches and Harbors <u>Waiver</u> (see attached pdf below, or contact below staff for blank copy) Each child must complete the waiver on or before 1<sup>st</sup> day of camp.
