## Cell Phone "Pings" Cancelled

Per <u>Penal Code sections 830, 1523, 1528(a) and 1524</u>, the information results of a Ping Warrant can only be received by law enforcement.

- As DCFS is not considered law enforcement, DCFS can no longer request a ping warrant through our Courts.
- The Office of County Counsel will continue looking for resources that will assist our cases.
- In the interim, if you have a case that you would like to seek a Ping Warrant, consult with the DCFS Child Abduction Team at <u>Child Abduction Unit@dcfs.lacounty.gov or (323)</u> 881-1303 to discuss requesting a Ping Warrant from law enforcement.
